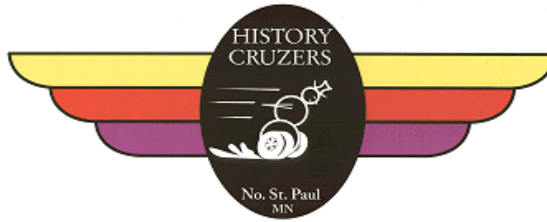

**Council approves new downtown parking ordinance**

The City Council approved an ordinance change. The new ordinance gives Council authority by resolution to restrict the parking of any motor vehicle, trailer, snowmobile, or bike of any kind in the Business District of the City.

The revised ordinance expands the definition of the Business District to include Charles St. from 8th Ave. E. (extending if from Charles and 7th Ave. E. The newly approved ordinance also adds the following restriction that from June 1 through October 1 that no vehicle shall park in any area of the Business District for more than two hours between the times of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

This line never went into full production and the trucks were destroyed except this one because one of the executives took it home. Dodge decided to back the next project, the Little Red Express came out after that.

I'm trying to find someone who would be interested in such a find and finish the restoration on it. It doesn't have all the original parts, but a very nice truck that would be a good investment and would be of higher value once completely restored. It has a 440 CI with a 727 transmission and has over 500 HP. It is orange with a new wooden bed installed in the back. My wife wants it out of the garage since I don't drive it.
